# **Supporting Life in Our Community**

Our council has recently completed a Baby Bottle Campaign (fundraiser) for the women's pregnancy resource center EmpowHerwrc, which provides services to expectant and post-partum mothers in the Port Charlotte and North Port, FL. areas. They provide expectant mothers with counseling services vital during pregnancy and support during the postpartum period for the short and long-term health and well-being of a woman and her newborn. Their services are provided free to women seeking their help. Here is a partial list of services they provide: pregnancy tests, pregnancy counseling, prenatal classes, parental training, community assistance, adoption referrals, and material assistance. Thanks to the generosity of the parishioners of St. Francis of Assisi, the KC Baby Bottle Campaign collected over \$5400 in donations. We will present a check for that amount to the Exec.Director of EmpowerHerwrc Inc. by the end of December.

# **Chancellor's Chat January 2025**

Happy New Year to you and your family; may the year bring you peace and prosperity! Here is some Catholic News from the Vatican: Pope Francis 'throws open' the Holy Door to St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve to inaugurate the 2025 Jubilee Year! The theme of the year is Jubilee of Hope. This Jubilee will extend from December 24 until the closing of the same door on the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord on January 6.

"During the Holy Year," the Pope has prayed," may the light of Christian hope illumine every man and woman, as a message of God's love addressed to all! And may the Church bear faithful witness to this message in every part of the world." The Pope recalled Saint Augustine (Doctor of the Church) suggesting that hope calls us to be upset with the things that are wrong and to find the courage to change them. Jubilee Years take place every 25 years, with the last Jubilee being ushered in by Pope St. John Paul II in 2000 as the Jubilee of Mercy. This tradition in the Catholic Church dates to Pope Martin V When he created the first Jubilee in 1423. The Holy Door is located on the rear wall of the Lateran Basilica. On 26 December, for the first time in the Jubilee tradition, Pope Francis will open a fifth sacred portal in a Roman prison, a gesture of hope

that shows his ongoing closeness to detainees. On Sunday, December 29, the Pope will open the Holy Door of his cathedral Saint John Lateran. Our Communion Breakfast which is on December 29 this year celebrates the 1700th anniversary of its dedication. Then on January 1st 2025, the Solemnity of Mary Mother of God, the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major will be opened. Lastly, Sunday, January 5th 2025, will mark the opening of the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. All of these four door openings will close on Sunday, December 28th, 2025.
